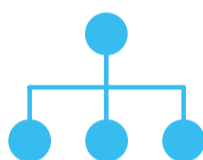


9 STEPS YOU CAN TAKE TO ENSURE DECISIONS ARE UNDERPINNED BY EVIDENCE
